Happy 2022! We are grateful as we round the corner of a new year and look ahead to hope and possibilities. After a robust 2021 season, the Jackson Park Farmers Market (JPFM) will be open again every Thursday from June 16th-September 29th, 2022 3:00pm-6:30pm in Jackson Park. This is our seventh season and we are continuing to support our community. We are pleased to say that we will continue to have WIC and the Senior Nutrition Program and will be adding SNAP/EBT. This allows us to better support customers and brings an additional stream of income to our vendors. If you sell items approved by SNAP/EBT we are expecting that you will accept the SNAP/EBT tokens. This year we will focus on incorporating youth voice to the market. This will come in the way of music, art and farming. It's an exciting venture as our youth will be our future vendors and customers!

At this time, COVID guidelines and recommendations are not yet known but will be updated as needed based on local/state guidelines.

We have not made any changes to our application process so you can choose what works best for you i.e. weekly or for the whole season. For our returning vendors, you will receive \$50.00 off a full-season rate if you recommend another vendor who attends/pays for at least four weeks at the market.
